Remuneration Committee

Makes recommendations on terms and conditions of employment including, pensions, remuneration, fees and travelling or other allowances payable to employees and to other persons providing services to the CCG.

Audit, Governance and Risk Committee

Provides an independent and objective view of the CCG's system of internal control including financial and business systems, performance information, financial information and compliance with laws, regulations and directions governing the CCG. Also provides assurance on corporate and other governance and risk management.

Quality Committee

Provides assurance on the CCGs processes and the quality and clinical effectiveness of commissioned services including patient safety, safeguarding children & young people and vulnerable adults, patient experience

Strategic Finance Committee

Review and provide assurance on strategic, operational and financial recovery plans, contract performance and procurement processes.

Primary Care Commissioning Committee (PCCC)

Makes collective decisions on the review, planning and procurement of primary care services under delegated authority from NHS England

BNSSG CCG GP Membership

Approve the Constitution and any changes. Shape the CCG's commissioning plans and ensure plans take account of local population needs. Approve the appointment of Governing Body GP members (Clinical Chair and Locality representatives) and arrangements for appointing them. Identify representatives to represent practices in matters concerning the work of the CCG. Nominate GP Practice representatives who meet as Commissioning Locality Groups (3 for Bristol, 2 in North Somerset and 1 in South Gloucestershire) in local forums at least 6 times per year and as BNSSG twice a year. GP Locality representatives on the Governing Body are nominated and appointed by Commissioning Locality Group members.

CCG Governing Body

(Strategy, Accountability and Governance)

Main function - Ensuring that the Group has appropriate arrangements in place to exercise its functions effectively, efficiently and economically and in accordance with the group's principles of good governance.

Approves the CCG's vision and strategy.

Commissioning Executive

Advises the Governing Body on clinical, strategic and operational planning matters and on decision making for the implementation of the CCG's plans.

Commissioning Locality Leadership Groups

3 Bristol, 2 North Somerset and 1 South Gloucestershire

Develop the local commissioning plans; engaging providers, patients and others.

Primary Care Operational Group

Oversees a programme of work to deliver the BNSSG Primary Care Strategy and GP Forward View making recommendations to the Primary Care Commissioning Committee

Commissioning Area Leadership Groups

One each for Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire

Contribute to the shaping of the CCG's commissioning plans, ensuring that the implementation of CCG-wide plans take account of local population needs and agree LA wide approaches.

Health and Wellbeing Boards in Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire

Clinical Policy Review Group

Develops clinical commissioning policies and recommends these to the Commissioning Executive

Healthier Together Partnership Board

Patient and Public Involvement Forum

Champion's robust and meaningful patient and public engagement
Ensures patient and public views are taken into consideration at Governing Body meetings

Area/Locality Patient and Public Involvement Groups

Reflect local views and aspirations to inform the CCG's decision-making

Maintain oversight and provide advice regarding the CCG's statutory responsibilities

BNSSG Area Prescribing and Medicine Optimisation Committee

Provide strategic leadership and advice to develop, manage and support the safe, effective and efficient optimisation of medicines across the local health system
