



What is the panel?



Our Healthier Together Citizens' panel is a responsive surveying tool that allows us to reach out to a broadly representative cross-section of our population.

Over the past three years, the panel has enabled us to ask a range of questions to provide us with a deeper understanding of our populations needs and wants.

How does it work?



The panel is a robust and representative sample of 1,239 people from across Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire. Panellists have been recruited by Jungle Green, a local market research company.

Surveys are primarily conducted online, with some taking part via phone and post.

What happens with the results?



We run a survey roughly every three months, with each survey themed around particular topics or priorities.

The results from the surveys are shared with colleagues across the Integrated Care System (ICS), on our website and with our panel members. The results are then used to shape and influence decision making on our plans for future health and care services.






