The Integrated Care Board (ICB)/Integrated Care System (ICS) is in the process of updating its strategic workforce plan. This will include ensuring that we implement the most effective approaches to support retention.
	During 2021/2 and 2022/3 there has been national (NHS England) investment in occupational health and well being across the ICS, with access for primary, community and secondary care. In addition, organisations in secondary care, and the main community provider invest in occupational health and well being for their staff.
