2. Is there a purpose for not wishing to present an identifying feature, eg a first name, as used by other public organisations?	The FOI team uses a generic inbox and signature for emails as members of our team have previously been subjected to personal abuse via email and the NHS has a zero-tolerance policy on this issue. The use of a generic inbox also provides resilience for the service when individuals are not working.
