4) The number of overnight and weekend shifts in 2022 at any of your out of hours providers in which just one GP was on duty	The requester would need to ask the provider (SevernSide IUC) directly as BNSSG ICB (Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire Integrated Care Board) does not hold this information; <u>https://www.severnside-iuc.co.uk/contact-us/</u> The ICB only asks SevernSide Integrated Urgent Care (IUC) service to notify the ICB if there are no GP's on duty, rather than when there is only 1 on duty.



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5) The number of patients covered by the out of hours providers where there was just one GP on duty for at least one shift in 2022 The requester would need to ask the provider as per question 4, the BNSSG ICB population is approximately 1 million.
