<p>Please provide:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) A copy of all the current APMS contracts for general practice in your area.	<p>We are unable to share individual contracts as the practice specific information is considered commercially sensitive, however the standard APMS contract is available here: https://www.england.nhs.uk/wp-content/uploads/2019/11/apms-contract-october-2019.pdf</p> <p>As the ICB considers the practice specific information commercially sensitive it has applied a Section 43(2) exemption to this response. Section 43(2) exempts information whose disclosure would, or be likely to, prejudice the commercial interests of any person (an individual, a company, the public authority itself or any other legal entity). Section 43(2) is a qualified exemption and therefore subject to the public interest test.</p> <p>The specifics of the individual contracts are considered commercially sensitive information Disclosure of the information would potentially be detrimental to primary care budgets or future procurement of services if disclosed. It is in the public interest for the ICB to be able to commission services at good value to ensure the availability of primary care funds to support other primary care service areas.</p>
