Drugs such as Paxlovid & Remdesivir were delivered / are being delivered via Nhs Covid Medicines Delivery Units (CMDUs), mainly via hospitals, rather than primary care, is this correct?	No. Within BNSSG Paxlovid is being delivered via the CMDU service within Primary Care. Remdesivir is not used in the CMDU service for non-hospitalised patients.
Does Paxlovid & Remdesivir prescribing based at secondary care only for some parts of England?	Not within BNSSG ICB.
How many secondary care patients received Paxlovid & Remdesivir from prescriptions in your Nhs Icb?	This information is not at ICB level
Which parts of your Nhs Icb area has Paxlovid & Remdesivir prescribing delivered at primary care?	For patients within BNSSG ICB Paxlovid is an option to be delivered within primary care. Remdesivir is not used in the CMDU service for non-hospitalised patients.
