 How many patient transport journeys were booked for discharging patients in 2021/22? 	The ICB funded contract for NEPTS (Non-Emergency Patient Transport Services) in 2021/22 was delivered by E-zec and there were 5,073 discharge journeys in 2021/22.

3. How many of these journeys were 'out of hours' and to non-contract providers? And how much did these cost?	All ICB funded discharge activity was managed by E-zec Medical, under contract, therefore no ICB discharge activity was delivered by non-contract providers.
	Of the 5,073 discharge journeys delivered by E-zec in 2021/22,
	1,272 were out of hours.

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	hospital to another. This can include Acute Hospitals to Mental Health Hospitals. This would include out of hours transport.
4. How do the hospitals book transportation for discharging patients? Is there an IT system?	All of the acute providers use Cleric for managing discharge bookings.
