<p>I am well aware from other FOI requests across the country, that if you are registered with a GP surgery in England and you are referred by a GP to a consultant or specialist in mental health, you have the legal right to choose the organisation (qualified provider) to whom you are referred, as long as that organisation is providing that service in another part of England.</p> <p>To enable patients to ask for a referral to be made to one of these organisations, they need to know what organisations have been awarded contracts.</p> <p>My request is therefore to know what contracts have been awarded by your ICB for</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.
