Is there a Digital Social Care Record in place?	Each local authority and care provider is responsible for maintaining their social care records. The ICB does not have a digital social care record, but has the capability to present this information within its shared care record, where the data is available and integration is in place. For BNSSG this is the case for the three local authorities' (Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire) DSCRs
If not, are plans underway to implement one?	See above
If yes, who is the supplier?	BNSG has a shared care record: Connecting Care, supplied by Orion Health. This is not a digital social care record



Does your ICS currently have a single Shared Care Record?	Yes – see above
Does your ICS currently have a single Shared Care Record?	Yes
If yes, are there plans to replace it?	The current contract with Orion Health to provide BNSSG's shared care record expires in November 2024. Plans are in place to replace this contract within these timeframes.
