For this reason, I would like to use the Freedom of Information Act to request all expenditure data over £25,000 for the following periods and CCGs:  1. Bristol CCG: January 2016 to February 2018 2. South Gloucestershire CCG: January 2016 to February 2018 3. North Somerset CCG: January 2016 to February 2018 Please can you provide the data in a machine readable format, such as a CSV.	Following the merger of the three separate CCGs in 2018, and then the formation of the ICB in July 2022, only some of the data has been transferred over. This information would have been available on the CCG website at the time; however this has since been moved to The National Archives.  Please find attached the data for Bristol CCG.
