Definitions

Spot Purchases Price - In Area (£ per bed day occupied)

This is classified as the average daily fee charged to you as an ICS for care provided to an individual who is occupying a bed **within ICS region** under an immediate requirement and is not contracted for and is made 'on the spot'

Spot Purchase Price - Out of Area cases (£ per bed day occupied)

This is classified as the average daily fee charged to you as an ICS for care provided to an individual who is occupying a bed **outside of ICS region but is paid for by you** under an immediate requirement and is not contracted for and is made 'on the spot'

Block contract (£ per patient under contract)

This is classified as the average amount spent per individual under a contract that is agreed upon by **you as an ICS with the relevant trusts in your ICS region**, to provide care for an individual needing an inpatient bed for either a severe MH condition, neuropsychiatry condition, or ABI bed in a level 3 neuro-rehab facility

Overall Average (in £)

Overall average cost of a patient in the event that there is no breakdown of the different types of fees indicated
