<p>Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, please can you provide me with information on dentistry funding in your ICS.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The total amount of your ICS budget in pounds-sterling (£) that is allocated for funding dentistry in each of the financial years a) 2023-2024, b) 2023-2022, c) 2022-2021, d) 2021-2020, e) 2020-2019</li><li>• The percentage of your ICSs total budget that is allocated for funding dentistry in each of the financial years a) 2023-2024, b) 2023-2022, c) 2022-2021, d) 2021-2020, e) 2020-2019</li></ul>	<p>For the purpose of answering the question, it has been assumed that the reference to ICS, which would be wider than the NHS, is in fact ICB Budget.</p> <p>Since Delegation of Dentistry to ICBs has only been for 2023-24 from the list of dates requested, the years requested before 2023-24 cannot be answered.</p> <p>The total Dental Budget at the end of January 2024, including Primary, Secondary &amp; Community for 2023/24 is £57.372m, this represents 2.67% of the ICB budget (2,147.861m).</p>
