NHS England has published the NHS plan for improving Long Covid services. This plan sets out the framework for Long Covid services in 2022/23, and an update on the actions set out in 2021. This plan has been developed with expert insights from those with lived experience of Long

It builds on the significant progress made over the past 2 years and sets out the action needed to ensure support is there for everyone who needs it, and patients requiring specialist assessment and treatment can access care in a timely way.

Long COVID prevalence - UK

2.1 million (3.3% of the population) people were experiencing self-reporting long COVID as of **4 Dec 2022** (data published 5 Jan 2023).

The previous data release, published on **1 Dec 2022** was **2.2 million** people (3.4% of the population).
