QUESTION	RESPONSE
We understand that, as of 2019/2020 around 11% of NHS funded Ophthalmic procedures are provided by three independent sector providers: Spamedica; Newmedica and Optegra. In addition, further procedures are provided by other smaller independent sector treatment centres such as the Independent Health Group, Practice Plus Group and Freedom Vision.	
According to the Royal College of Ophthalmologists' blueprint for delivering cataract training in the independent sector "every independent sector sector provider delivering NHS-funded cataract surgery must be able to train NHS ophthalmic trainees on at least 11% of whole cases within 2 years in every region". This is also in line with the NHS England's 2022 cataract service specification.
